Fruit Co-Op Facility

Structure Type: Tilt-Up Building

Project Type: Industrial

Location: North Central WA

Products: ColorFlo Liquid Color

Overview: Available floor space is exceptionally important in warehouses, production facilities, and other industrial spaces. For this reason, tilt-up construction is a popular choice for these kinds of buildings.

In this case, a regional fruit cooperative needed a processing and storage facility to service grocers with fresh, locally grown fruit. By using tilt-up construction, the co-op was able to maximize floor space. For further benefit, the precast and tilt-up panels were cast with integrated foam insulation.

To visually integrate into the surrounding landscape, architects chose to color the tilt-up and precast panels using Solomon Colors ColorFlo 306 Canvas and 385 Bark. The tilt-up contractor used a Solomon Colors ColorSelect Single Color System to dispense pigment on site. Single Color systems are well suited to large scale projects using a large volume of color—especially on remote jobsites.
