Overview: The Cincinnati Zoo is one of the oldest and most respected zoos in the United States. As part of an ongoing campaign to increase habitat size for the animals, the zoo opened the Roo Valley exhibit. Roo Valley is a walkabout kangaroo habitat where guests can get up close with kangaroos. It also features a large Little Blue Penguin outdoor enclosure.

Stamped concrete was the natural choice for the meandering path through the exhibit. The Rough Stone seamless skin created an easy to traverse surface that visually blended with the surrounding boulders, rock faces and foliage. The pattern and color combination blended well with the Australian theme of the exhibit.
