Overview: Built in 1909, this building features a luxury hotel, fine dining restaurant, rooftop bar, and event space. It is nestled adjacent a historic park in downtown Cincinnati. As part of a major renovation, various stamped concrete designs were chosen to compliment the vintage setting and upscale clientele. This afforded a variety of finishes suited to each area without sacrificing durability against traffic and environmental concerns.

By using multiple stamp patterns and different – but complimentary – color schemes, the contractor was able to create the feeling of different spaces for different purposes. A seamless texture skin on the sidewalk and porte cochere ensure an easy walking surface with minimal trip hazard. Various cobble and stone textures compliment the historic building and setting elsewhere where foot traffic is lower.

Porte Cochere: Roman Slate Texture, Desert Tan Color Hardener and Dark Gray Antique Release

Sidewalk: Roman Slate Texture, Desert Tan Color Hardener and Medium Gray Antique Release

Fireplace: Cobblestone Radius, Autumn Brown Color Hardener and Dark Gray Antique Release

Patio: Unknown Stamp and Color Hardener, Light Gray Antique Release, various ARTesian Stains
